## OATH TAKING CEREMONY

The Oath Taking Ceremony of the newly elected office bearers and executive members of the Rawalpindi Chamber of Commerce and Industry (RCCI) for the term 2024-2026 was held at a local hall in Rawalpindi.

Mr. Sohail Altaf, Group Leader of RCCI, appreciated the commendable efforts of the outgoing team and extended a warm welcome to the newly elected members. He emphasized the critical role the Chamber plays in supporting the business community and expressed confidence in the new leadership's ability to take RCCI to greater heights.

During the ceremony, Mr. Usman Shaukat was sworn in as the President of RCCI, Mr. Khalid Farooq Qazi assumed office as the Senior Vice President, and Mr. Fahad Barlas was appointed as the Vice President. The oath

was administered by Mr. Sohail Altaf, who congratulated the newly elected officials and executive members on their successful election.

The event was attended by Former Presidents, members from trade associations, diplomats, friends from media and a large number of RCCI members. The presence of these esteemed individuals highlighted the Chamber's continued focus on fostering unity and collaboration within the business community.

The newly elected President, Mr. Usman Shaukat, in his address, expressed his gratitude for the trust placed in him and the executive team. He outlined his vision for RCCI focus on enhancing member services, promoting trade and investment, and strengthening ties with both local and international business communities.

Usman Shaukat said the early completion of Rawalpindi Ring Road Project will be actively pursued with the relevant authorities and termed it a game changer project for the Rawalpindi.

Describing the project as a major infrastructure initiative, he said the creation of a circular road around the city would improve connectivity, reduce traffic congestion, and stimulate economic growth by providing an efficient transportation corridor.

Usman Shaukat also said an industrial zone will be developed exclusively for Rawalpindi alongside the ring road. He said an RCCI think-tank on economy headed by Sohail Altaf will be made effective and active in policy making and business promotion with the relevant government departments.





# RCCI DELEGATION CALLS ON COMMISSIONER RAWALPINDI

A delegation from the Rawalpindi Chamber of Commerce and Industry (RCCI), led by President Mr. Usman Shaukat, called on Commissioner Rawalpindi, Engineer Aamir Khattak, to discuss ongoing and development projects in the city. The meeting focused on the progress of the Ring Road project, the establishment of economic and industrial zones, and other critical infrastructure/Civic developments. The delegation included RCCI Group Leader Sohail Altaf, Senior Vice President Khalid Farooq Qazi, Vice President Fahad Barlas, former Presidents Asad Mashadi and Saqib Rafiq, along with executive committee members. Commissioner Aamir Khattak briefed the RCCI delegation on the progress of the Ring Road project, stating that Phase One is on track for completion by March-April 2025. He also nominated a focal person to coordinate briefings on the Rawalpindi Master Plan including establishment of industrial zones around the Ring. The Commissioner also informed that the Deputy Commissioner's office and the Rawalpindi Development Authority (RDA) would soon provide detailed briefings at RCCI. During the meeting,



the Commissioner also discussed the expanded role of the waste management company under the "Suthra Punjab" initiative, now covering 22 Tehsils across the division. Enhanced sanitation efforts, along with fencing, road construction, and the creation of green belts along Lai Nullah, are being prioritized. Additionally, the Commissioner committed to visiting the Rawat Industrial Estate to personally review the construction and patchwork on the link road. Matters related to the Kechhari Chowk expansion, the construction of a link road to the Rawat Industrial Estate, the paving of

the road to Rak Dhamial Graveyard, and issues related to the encroachments, traffic management, and corporate social responsibility (CSR) to assist those in need also came in discussion. President Usman Shaukat expressed the Chamber's full support for these development projects and assured Commissioner Khattak of RCCI's continued collaboration. He extended an invitation for the Commissioner to visit the Chamber and meet with the local business community, which was accepted.

## RCCI President calls on Dr. Maen Khreasat, Ambassador of Jordan in Pakistan

A delegation of Rawalpindi Chamber of Commerce and Industry (RCCI) led by President Usman Shaukat visited the Embassy of The Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan - Islamabad and called on H.E. Dr. Maen Khreasat, Ambassador of Jordan in Pakistan. Vice President Fahad Barlas, and EC member Ms. Falak Anjum were also present on the occasion. During the meeting a wide range of areas for further enhancing bilateral trade and economic relations between Jordan and Pakistan were also discussed.

Matters related to bilateral trade, investment opportunities, networking & chamber to chamber connectivity & visit of trade delegation from both sides to enhance trade relations and to explore the potential cooperation

between both countries also came under discussion.

Ambassador Dr. Maen A.M. Khreasat

said that Jordan valued its historical and friendly relations with Pakistan and was keen to further enhance its trade ties with it for mutual benefit.

He said that his country was keen to expand its trade ties with Pakistan through enhanced bilateral cooperation across various sectors including tourism, Agricultural, hospitality and health services.

RCCI President Usman Shaukat in his remarks emphasized RCCI's commitment to facilitating joint ventures, promoting bilateral trade,



and enhancing investment opportunities. He also highlighted the chamber's readiness to assist in organizing business forums, trade delegations, and cultural exchange programs to strengthen the ties between the two nations.

He reiterated that RCCI would work tirelessly to support initiatives aimed at mutual growth and development, ensuring a prosperous partnership between Pakistan and Jordan.

# RCCI Delegation calls on Deputy Commissioner Rawalpindi to Discuss Key Development and Civic Issues



A delegation led by RCCI President Usman Shaukat called on Deputy Commissioner Rawalpindi, Dr. Hassan Waqar Cheema, to discuss progress on various key projects and civic concerns in the city. Senior Vice President Khalid Farooq Qazi, Vice President Fahad Barlas, Former President Saqib Rafiq, and members of the RCCI Executive Committee were also present during the meeting.

The meeting focused on several critical issues, including the ongoing Ring Road project and the development of economic zones around it. The delegation discussed in detail the potential benefits of these zones for the city's economy and emphasized the need to expedite their construction. In response, Deputy Commissioner Dr. Hassan Waqar Cheema assured the RCCI that the Ring Road project would be completed by June 2025. He said that a Central Business District (CBD) is

also being established which will increase commercial activity. He also appreciated the Chamber's proposals regarding the establishment of economic zones around the Ring Road, acknowledging their importance in boosting local commerce and infrastructure.

During the discussion, President Usman Shaukat pledged the RCCI's full support for the Dengue Prevention Campaign, affirming the Chamber's commitment to launching a special awareness drive among the business community. However, he raised concerns about the strict measures being taken under anti-dengue regulations, including the sealing of business centers and FIRs against businessmen. He stressed that such extreme measures cause unnecessary fear and harassment in the business community, urging a more balanced approach.

The delegation also addressed the pressing issues of encroachments and parking problems in various commercial areas of Rawalpindi, such as Sadar Cantt, Tench Bhatta, Commercial Market, and Raja Bazaar. President Usman Shaukat highlighted the need for a comprehensive plan to eliminate encroachments and alleviate parking challenges, which are hindering smooth business operations. Deputy Commissioner Cheema assured that the administration would take the Chamber's suggestions into consideration and work towards a sustainable solution.

# RCCI Delegation Calls on Station Commander Rawalpindi Concerns Raised Over Bank Road Pedestrianization



A delegation from the Rawalpindi Chamber of Commerce and Industry (RCCI), led by President Usman Shaukat, had a meeting with Station Commander Brigadier Ahmed Nawaz at the Station Headquarters Rawalpindi to discuss important matters concerning the development and facilitation of the business community in the Cantt. area. The delegation also included group leader Sohail Altaf and former RCCI President Syed Asad Mashadi.

A primary issue raised during the meeting was the potential impact of converting Bank Road into a pedestrian-only street. RCCI highlighted concerns that this change could negatively affect the businesses operating along the road. President Usman Shaukat urged a reconsideration of the plan, citing the importance of vehicular access for customers.

In response, Station Commander Brigadier Ahmed Nawaz suggested that if the business community, particularly on Bank Road, cooperates by parking their staff vehicles and motorcycles in designated parking areas, the pedestrianization plan can be reverted.

Agreeing to the proposal of the station commander, President Usman Shaukat said that in this regard, in the presence of station commander and Anjuman Tajran representatives, a solution will be found with consensus. He also invited the station commander to visit the RCCI which he accepted and said that he will visit the chamber next week and meet the businessmen for an interactive session.

Matters related to the beautification, expediting the progress on Rawalpindi Ring Road, cleanliness, representation of business community and chamber in the Cantonment Board also came in discussion.

## A HIGH-LEVEL UZBEKISTAN TRADE DELEGATION, LED BY AMBASSADOR MR. ALISHER TUKHTAEV, VISITED RCCI



A high-level Uzbekistan trade delegation, led by Ambassador Mr. Alisher Tukhtaev, visited the Rawalpindi Chamber of Commerce and Industry (RCCI) to discuss opportunities for enhancing bilateral trade and cooperation. The delegation included key representatives from various sectors: Tukhtaev Akorbirjon, Deputy Chairman of the Chemical Industry Association (Uzkimyosanoat), Mr. Halimjon Safarov, Deputy Chairman of the Uzbek Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Bakhrom Yusupov, Commercial Consular and Hamid Mahmood, Representative of the Ministry of Tourism, Uzbekistan. Ambassador Mr. Alisher Tukhtaev, in his address, thanked RCCI for the warm reception and provided an

overview of the growing trade relations between the two countries. He noted that bilateral trade has grown significantly by 50 to 55 percent annually over the past three years, increasing from USD 50 million to USD 240 million last year. He also shared positive news regarding the resumption of direct flights between Pakistan and Uzbekistan, expected in November or December of this year, and stated that visa issues for tourists have been resolved. Mr. Tukhtaev Akorbirjon, Deputy Chairman of Uzkimyosanoat, delivered a detailed presentation on Uzbekistan's chemical industry, sharing key figures on the production of over 150 products, including urea, fertilizers, polyethylene, and medical disinfectants, with 78 products being

exported. RCCI President Usman Shaukat warmly welcomed the delegation and highlighted the strong potential for expanding trade relations between Pakistan and Uzbekistan in sectors such as energy, pharmaceuticals, textiles, agriculture, chemical industry, and tourism. The meeting concluded with the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to strengthen joint cooperation and enhance trade ties between Pakistan and Uzbekistan. Senior Vice President Khalid Farooq Qazi, Vice President Fahad Barlas, Executive committee members and a large number of RCCI members were also present on the occasion.

## Bosnian Ambassador Emin Cohodarevic Visits RCCI to Explore Bilateral Trade and Investment Opportunities



The Rawalpindi Chamber of Commerce and Industry (RCCI) warmly welcomed H.E. Emin Cohodarevic, the Ambassador of Bosnia & Herzegovina, during his visit to the Chamber. The meeting focused on strengthening bilateral trade and investment ties between Pakistan and Bosnia & Herzegovina, with discussions covering key sectors such as tourism, metals, mining, energy, food processing, textiles, and agricultural machinery. Ambassador Cohodarevic highlighted the immense cultural and historical heritage of

Bosnia & Herzegovina and pointed out the great potential for collaboration in various fields. He underscored that both nations can significantly benefit from each other's strengths, emphasizing the importance of reactivating the Joint Economic Commission (JEC) to enhance trade and investment between the two countries. In response, RCCI President expressed appreciation for the Ambassador's visit and reaffirmed the Chamber's full commitment to supporting initiatives that promote closer business ties. He assured all-out

efforts to facilitate networking, information exchange, and enhanced chamber-to-chamber relations between Pakistan and Bosnia & Herzegovina. "We are dedicated to building stronger ties between our two nations, and the RCCI is ready to assist in expanding business connections, creating networking opportunities, and sharing valuable market information," said the RCCI President. The meeting was also attended by Senior Vice President Khalid Farooq Qazi, Vice President Fahad Barlas, executive committee members, and prominent traders.

## Kyrgyzstan Ambassador Avazbek Atakhanov Visits RCCI, Emphasizes Potential for Expanding Bilateral Trade



The Ambassador of Kyrgyzstan to Pakistan, H.E. Avazbek Atakhanov, visited the Rawalpindi Chamber of Commerce and Industry (RCCI) and met with RCCI President Usman Shaukat. The meeting, which was attended by RCCI Senior Vice President Khalid Farooq Qazi, Vice President Fahad Barlas, and other RCCI members, focused on strengthening economic and trade ties between Pakistan and Kyrgyzstan. RCCI President Usman Shaukat

provided an overview of RCCI's ongoing activities and upcoming events, highlighting the potential for joint ventures in sectors such as pharmaceuticals, agriculture, and tourism. Acknowledging the modest \$20 million trade volume between the two nations, he called for increased interaction and cooperation to realize their shared economic potential. Ambassador Atakhanov expressed optimism about boosting the trade volume to \$500 million, underscoring

Kyrgyzstan's interest in deepening ties with Pakistan. "Pakistan offers unique opportunities, from the bustling port of Gwadar to the scenic Karakorams," He highlighted Kyrgyzstan's historical ties with Pakistan and stressed the need to foster close relations. The ambassador also discussed Kyrgyzstan's relaxed visa policies, enabling easier access for visitors from 62 countries, with plans to further ease restrictions for Pakistani businessmen, investors, and tourists.

## Iraqi Ambassador Hamid Abbas Lafta Visits RCCI, urges for strengthening trade volume



The Ambassador of Iraq to Pakistan, H.E. Hamid Abbas Lafta, visited the Rawalpindi Chamber of Commerce and Industry (RCCI) and engaged in discussions with RCCI President Usman Shaukat on enhancing trade and diplomatic relations between the two countries. Ambassador Lafta was accompanied by Ayad Ayub Saadi and Shahbaz Ahmed, and was welcomed by RCCI leadership, including Senior Vice President Khalid Farooq Qazi, Vice President Fahad Barlas, and Executive Committee members. In his welcome address, President Usman Shaukat thanked the

Ambassador for his visit and provided an overview of RCCI's activities, highlighting business opportunities within the region. He noted the current bilateral trade volume of approximately \$240 million, emphasizing untapped potential in sectors such as pharmaceuticals, textiles, food, and energy. Ambassador Hamid Abbas Lafta reiterated Iraq's commitment to strengthening diplomatic and trade ties with Pakistan, underscoring the shared historical, religious, and diplomatic bonds between the two nations. While acknowledging the low trade volume,

he highlighted the opportunity for increased commerce.

He assured the RCCI of Iraq's support in facilitating the participation of Pakistani businesses in Iraqi exhibitions and trade delegations to expand trade and economic collaboration.

The meeting concluded with a mutual commitment to deepen commercial ties and foster a stronger economic partnership between Iraq and Pakistan. In the end RCCI President Usman Shaukat presented the chamber memento to the Iraqi envoy for his visit to the chamber house.

# RCCI Holds Think Tank Session on Economic Challenges and Future Directions



The Rawalpindi Chamber of Commerce and Industry (RCCI) hosted a high-level think tank session focused on assessing Pakistan's current economic situation and identifying solutions for sustainable growth. The session was chaired by RCCI President Usman Shaukat, alongside Think Tank Chairman and Group Leader Sohail Altaf, and featured renowned economist and economic analyst Dr. Farrukh Saleem as the chief guest.

Dr. Farrukh Saleem highlighted several positive economic indicators, noting that inflation rates have fallen, while exports and remittances have shown encouraging growth. However, he emphasized the need for reform in key areas, including fiscal deficit management, government spending, and foreign debt reduction, while pointing out growth potential in energy, agriculture, and industrial sectors. Dr. Saleem also advocated for the privatization of loss-making state-owned enterprises, such as Pakistan International Airlines (PIA),

suggesting that the government should focus on regulation, leaving business activities to the private sector.

President RCCI Usman Shaukat underscored the purpose of the think tank, which is to not only evaluate economic challenges but also to propose actionable solutions. "Continuity of policies is essential to address our economic challenges and guide Pakistan toward stability," he added.

Chairman Think Tank and Group Leader Sohail Altaf called on all political parties to unite on an economic stability agenda, much like the 26th constitutional amendment, to help Pakistan emerge from the economic quagmire. He highlighted the excessive tax burden on current taxpayers, citing the high tax rates of up to 50% in the region, and recommended an expansion of the tax net alongside incentives for businesses to stimulate economic growth.

Vice Chairman and former RCCI President Raja Aamir Iqbal

emphasized the need for a comprehensive approach to address the growing trade deficit, which has risen by 29% in the first quarter of the year. He noted worrying trends in cement and tractor production, which have dropped by 20% and 50%, respectively, and called for collaboration with stakeholders to create sustainable economic policies that will reduce national debt and foster business-friendly reforms.

The session included a Q&A segment, where participants engaged with experts on pressing economic topics such as inflation, interest rates, production costs, stock market trends, IMF loans, and national debt.

Distinguished attendees included RCCI Vice Chairman Think Tank Raja Amir Iqbal, Senior Vice President Khalid Farooq Qazi, Vice President Fahad Barlas, former RCCI Presidents, and Executive Committee members, along with other prominent figures from the business community.



## Mushaal Hussein Mullick Visits RCCI, Stands in Solidarity with Kashmiri and Palestinian People



A ceremony expressing solidarity with the Kashmiri and Palestinian people was held at the Rawalpindi Chamber of Commerce and Industry (RCCI), featuring Ms. Mushaal Hussein Mullick, Chairperson of the Peace and Culture Organization and wife of imprisoned Kashmiri leader Muhammad Yasin Malik, as the chief guest. RCCI President Usman Shaukat, in his welcome speech, emphasized the Chamber's commitment to standing with the Kashmiri people in their struggle, reaffirming the support of Pakistan's business community. He urged the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) and the United Nations to take immediate notice of the ongoing human rights violations in

Kashmir. In her remarks to media representatives, Ms. Mushaal Mullick expressed gratitude to RCCI for its steadfast support of the Kashmir cause and highlighted the urgent need to address the plight of Kashmiri and Palestinian people. She detailed the severe restrictions and economic suppression imposed on Kashmiris, noting that over 5,000 mosques have been demolished and resources redirected to alter the region's demographic and economic landscape. Mullick warned that the systematic allotment of land to large Indian businesses and voting rights for 5 million Hindus in Kashmir undermines the rights of the Kashmiri people. Ms. Mullick underscored that such

suppression could lead to further instability in the region, cautioning that unresolved tensions could escalate. She stressed that a solution is urgently needed to ensure lasting peace and highlighted the detrimental effects of occupation on local economies. The event concluded with a symbolic walk to reinforce solidarity with Kashmir and Palestine. Among the attendees were RCCI Senior Vice President Khalid Farooq Qazi, Vice President Fahad Barlas, Executive Committee Members, former Presidents Raja Aamir Iqbal and Saqib Rafiq, and a large gathering of Chamber members and civil society representatives.
